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## **Program Overview**

The Dream2Screen Acting Program is a structured, industry-focused training experience designed to guide young actors from their first performance assessment to professional, industry-ready materials. Training reflects real audition processes and professional expectations.

## **How the Dream2Screen Program Works**

- 1 Performance assessment to understand the actor's current level.
- 2 Audition-based training through real-world scenarios.
- 3 On-camera performance development through self-tapes, monologues, and scenes.
- 4 Education on the business side of acting.
- 5 Guidance toward professional materials upon completion.

## **Session 1: Performance Assessment**

Actors perform a prepared monologue to assess confidence, technique, and on-camera presence. Individual feedback and goal setting are provided.

## **Phase 1: Audition Preparation & Technique**

Introduction to the four core acting tools used throughout the program: acting beats, objectives, obstacles, and tactics.

## **Commercial Auditions**

Focus on natural, authentic, and bookable performances.

## **One-Liner Auditions**

Actors learn to rely on imagination and discoveries to create full characters with minimal dialogue.

## **Actor, Principal, Supporting & Leading Role Auditions**

Students learn how to build characters, carry scenes, and understand role responsibility.

### **Phase 2: Self-Tape Mastery**

Training on framing, lighting, sound, reader placement, editing, and submission standards.

### **Phase 3: Performance Development**

Focused monologue and scene work to strengthen emotional truth, listening skills, and on-camera confidence.

### **Phase 4: The Business of Acting**

Actors learn about agents, casting directors, contracts, professionalism, and allowable expenses.

### **Phase 5: Professional Materials**

Upon completion, actors receive guidance toward headshots, demo reels, resumes, and agent submissions.
